Hello Michigan fans! Today the Wolverines are facing the Jaguars of Indiana University - Purdue University Indianapolis (IUPUI). That is not a typo. The Jaguars hosted the Division II Saint Joseph's College in an exhibition game to start the season, winning by only 13 points and being outscored in the second half. After the game, IUPUI's star player, Darell Combs, stated, "We usually don't have this many turnovers in practice, but it was just one of those nights." Maybe that's because you are practicing against your own team, Darell.

**Briefly:** Last season, the Jaguars finished with a not-so-great 13-19 record, but a respectable 9-7 record in conference play. They finished the season in 4th place in the Summit League, but had the second lowest overall win percentage in the conference. IUPUI also had trouble winning games on the road last season, going 4-17 on away and neutral sites.

One and Only: IUPUI basketball has had only one player selected in the NBA Draft throughout its history, George Hill of the Utah Jazz. Hill averaged 17 PPG in his four years at IUPUI, but despite his admirable efforts, IUPUI never made the NCAA tournament during the years he was on the team. In fact, the Jaguars have only made the big dance once in their 16 years as a Division I basketball team. This happened in 2003. They promptly lost their first game of the tournament by 31 points, which believe it or not is still less than the number of letters in the name of their school.
