In tonight's exhibition, Michigan will be taking on the Armstrong State Pirates. With faces new and old amongst the players and coaches, there's certainly a lot to look forward to this season. Homecoming: Tonight we're honored to welcome back a Michigan basketball legend, Armstrong State's assistant coach Cazzie Russell. There's a reason Crisler Center is sometimes called "The House that Cazzie Built,": during the 60's, Cazzie led Michigan to three straight Big Ten titles and a Final Four before being selected first overall in the 1966 NBA Draft. Cazzie made such am impact while at Michigan that, in 1993, his jersey number was retired and raised to the rafters. While we won't be rooting for Cazzie today, we're glad to have him back in Ann Arbor!

Abandon Ship?: While the Pirates have seen improvement under Coach Evans Davis, going 12-15 and posting a winning conference record in the Peach Belt Conference last season, it's hard to tell how this year's squad will fare. That's because Armstrong State only returns three players from last year's team, George Brown, Corey Tillery (#3), and Jamison Jeffers. The rest of the Pirates are either freshmen or transfers.
