On The Rise: After struggling with shooting the ball in previous outings—including 19-of-83 (23%) on three-pointers versus EMU, Arizona, and SMU—the Wolverines are finally regaining the offensive success that was so integral earlier in the season. The Wolverines began last Monday's game against Coppin State on a 11-0 run, and finished the first half shooting 6-14 (42.9%) from beyond the arc. Freshmen Ricky Doyle and Mark Donnal were just as impressive in the opening half, scoring a combine 15 points on 6-for-6 shooting.

A Moment For The Ages: Last Monday, freshman Austin Hatch, a survivor of two plane crashes, scored his first regular season point in the waning moments of the Wolverines' win over Coppin State. Coming off a four-game losing streak, the Wolverines needed a spark.
