Good afternoon Maize Rage and welcome to Crisler for the last time of the 2017-18 season! Muhammad-Ali Abdur-Rahkman, Duncan Robinson, Jaaron Simmons, and Austin Hatch will be honored on Senior Day as Michigan takes on the Ohio State Buckeyes. The Buckeyes are coming off of a 79-56 loss at Penn State on Thursday night, so they will be even more fired up to play today. Today's game is a Maize Out, so let's keep the energy going to make this an intimidating atmosphere for the Buckeyes to deal with.

Welcome Back, Old Friend: While it may be hard to get over the fact that Andrew Dakich chose Ohio State as a his grad transfer destination after four years at Michigan, you can't blame him for seizing an opportunity to earn a scholarship and play significant minutes on a Big Ten team. Let's cheer for him and only him like we did for Spike Albrecht last year and Max Bielfeldt the year before.

Breakout Stars: Ohio State has greatly exceeded preseason expectations in Chris Holtmann's first year due to the improvement of Keita Bates-Diop and C.J. Jackson. Bates-Diop has increased his scoring average from 9.7 PPG to 19.6 PPG this season, and Jackson is scoring 12.5 PPG this year, up from 5.6 PPG a year ago.

The Butler Way: Chris Holtmann is the second consecutive Ohio State head coach to have previously coached at Butler, as Thad Matta coached the Bulldogs from 2000-01, while Holtmann spent the past three seasons (2014-17) coaching at Butler.

Splash City: Duncan Robinson scored 18 points, all from deep, against lowa on Wednesday. At one point, Robinson made threes on three consecutive possessions, and is now 10 for his last 15 attempts from behind the arc.

Dropping Dimes: Muhammad-Ali Abdur-Rahkman was great against lowa, scoring 18 points and adding 7 assists. The 7 assists were a season-high, and Abdur-Rahkman now leads the country in assist/turnover ratio at 6.0.

Picking Pockets: Michigan forced 16 turnovers against lowa, including a season-high 13 steals. Michigan only turned the ball over 6 times in the game and grabbed 11 offensive rebounds, helping the team register 15 more shot attempts than the Hawkeyes, including 23 more attempted threes.
