Good evening Maize Rage and welcome back to Crisler Center! Your Wolverines are fresh off an unforgettable National Title Game run, the second in 6 years under Head Coach John Beilein, and are poised to make another deep tournament run this year. But they need your energy tonight, as we welcome the Northwood Timberwolves to Ann Arbor for an exhibition to open the season. The Timberwolves limp into Crisler after an 86-66 blowout loss at Western Michigan last Saturday in the team's first exhibition game. Basketball is back, so let's pick up from where we left off last year and get this place popping!

The OTHER Timberwolves: No Jimmy Butler controversy on this team! The Northwood Timberwolves hail from Midland, Michigan and represent the GLIAC in NCAA's Division II. While not a basketball powerhouse from any angle you look at them, Northwood returns some experienced leaders in senior forward Zach Allread and junior guard Trey McBride. The team hopes to increase their season win total for a second consecutive season. And while it would only take 12 to accomplish that feat, hey, everyone needs to have goals.

Bronco Busted: A promising first half on Saturday against the Western Michigan Broncos turned disastrous for Northwood as the second 20-minute period began. A one point halftime deficit quickly ballooned into twelve, as Western scored the first 11 points of the half. From there, Western's lead never got below 10, though it got as high as 24. Northwood shot an abysmal 33.3% from the field in the second half and were paced by freshman reserve Jack Ammerman's 15 points for the game.
